

IFT Annual Awards FAQs 2024

Do you have to be a an IFT member or partner to enter for an award?

No. The IFT Awards are open to any organisation, company or individual connected to, or working within turnaround and transformation – or to any company that has undergone a successful turnaround process.

How do I submit my entry?

We use a survey tool to collect awards submissions. Please **DO NOT** submit your application until you have all of the required information as you cannot save and edit your submission.

A full list of questions and guidance in relation to questions is available on our website.

Can I upload additional material such as articles or videos as part of my entry?

You can send links to articles or videos, but please do not send any other form of presentation. Please contact info@the-ift.com if you have questions relating to additional information.

Do you offer feedback on entries?

Yes, please contact us if you would like feedback after the awards event has taken place.

Does my entry remain confidential?

Submissions to the judging panel are confidential. We will not publish your submission, but do ask you to provide a summary that we can use in promotional materials and in preparation for the ceremony. Please be aware that we will be contacting these referees so it is crucial that you get support from the firm subject to the turnaround prior to submitting for an award. We will not share your submission, but we will contact them to ask about your involvement in this case.

What happens if my entry is shortlisted?

We'll let you know if your entry is shortlisted in September 2024 when the shortlist is published online. Winners will be announced at our awards ceremony on 17th October 2024. We will share social media panels to enable you to easily share the good news.

Who judges the entries?

Our judging panel is drawn from experienced professionals across the transformation and turnaround community. Together they have significant experience across turnaround practice, advisory, lending, investment and legal counsel.

If someone in our organisation is a judge, can we still enter the awards?

Yes, but the judge will not take part in the judging of any category in which you've entered.

Can I make multiple entries in a single category?

Yes, but you may wish your strategy in this regard.

Can I submit a case that has been submitted in a prior year?

Yes, if the case has been subject to material change in terms of turnaround outcomes, re-submissions are welcomed.

Can I submit myself/my company?

Yes, you may submit yourself for the individual awards, or your company for the individual company awards – and we also accept submissions for individuals or companies by firms or lenders. The credentials are checked via the referee process as for all awards.
